Student Attendance

Attendance Reporting and Notifications

Families can expect automated attendance messages by email, phone, and text if a child is absent and their absence has not already been reported by a parent/guardian. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to report an absence or reply to the automated email or phone message. It is very helpful to have absence notifications **ahead of time** so that student attendance records can be updated <u>prior</u> to teachers marking the student absent (AB). This prevents unnecessary push notifications going out from the District. You can report a full day absence via ParentVue or a partial day absence via the LMS website (I'd like to... Report an absence...), or by simply calling the LMS attendance line at 913/239-5305.

What is the purpose of attendance notifications?

We realize that students may occasionally need to miss school for planned absences, illnesses, and appointments. However, when a student does not arrive at school or unexpectedly misses a portion of the school day, we are concerned and want to make sure you are aware that your child is absent.

How can I get push notifications?

Families who would also like a push notification can download the ParentVUE app and manage their notifications. If a child has an unreported absence when a teacher submits attendance, then a push

notification will immediately be sent to the parent/guardian's mobile device.

Interested in push notifications? Simply download the ParentVUE app (<u>iTunes app store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>), enable push notifications in device settings and select attendance notifications through in-app settings. Once the app is downloaded, <u>these instructions</u> will help you complete the set-up.
