  - WSU Teacher Education Graduate (Minimum GPA 2.750)
  - Graduate from NCATE Accredited Program (3.00 GPA or better)
  - 2.75 GPA and GRE Scores of 152 Verbal and 153 Quantitative
  - Alternative evidence documenting academic aptitude
- Provide a statement of your involvement in Teaching, Training, Instructional Design or Recommendation by the Graduate Committee
