## Optional form for Parent Input on Class Placement

One of the biggest concerns of most parents is classroom placement each year for their students at school. I'm sharing our current procedure for placing students in classes with that in mind.

In the spring, current grade classroom teachers, building learning specialists, the counselor, and the principal meet to discuss student needs and form initial classes for the upcoming year. There are always changes during the summer due to new students that may enroll. With over 400 students to consider at Prairie Star Elementary, we take this task very seriously to end up with classes where students can thrive. We work hard to develop classes that include:

- A mix of boys and girls
- A range of academic abilities
- Compatible student personalities
- Overall class sizes that are approximately equal across the grade level

Parent input in this process is undoubtedly welcome if parents want to share information about their child that we might not already know. The parent input form (attached) has been designed for this purpose. Parents who complete the optional input form will need to have the form **completed and turned in to the office by April 15, 2025.**

To begin the registration process for the 2025-26 school year, simply go to

[www.bluevalleyk12.org/registration](http://www.bluevalleyk12.org/registration) and click **New Student Registration** in the Useful Links. Families new to Blue Valley will be asked to create an online parent account. Online registration will take approximately 20 minutes to complete and it is an important step in getting your student started with kindergarten! You will be asked to pay fees later this spring.

**Please note:** If your child is currently enrolled in the Blue Valley early childhood program, you will not complete online registration at this time. Families transitioning from early childhood to kindergarten will have an opportunity to verify the information and complete the registration process later this spring.

To make Blue Valley's Online Registration process smooth and convenient, please have the following information available:

- Student proof of identity (birth certificate)
- Emergency contact name(s) and phone number(s)
- Doctor, dentist and preferred hospital contact info
- Immunization record and health assessment (physical)
- Proof of residency (purchase contract, lease or current utility bill)
- Custodial documentation (if applicable)
- Previous school records and contact info
- IEP or 504 Plan (if applicable)

**Tip:** As soon as your child's registration is complete, you will begin receiving all-school communication items that will help welcome you and your family into the school community.

We will say farewell to our 5th-grade students with a small ceremony in the gym.

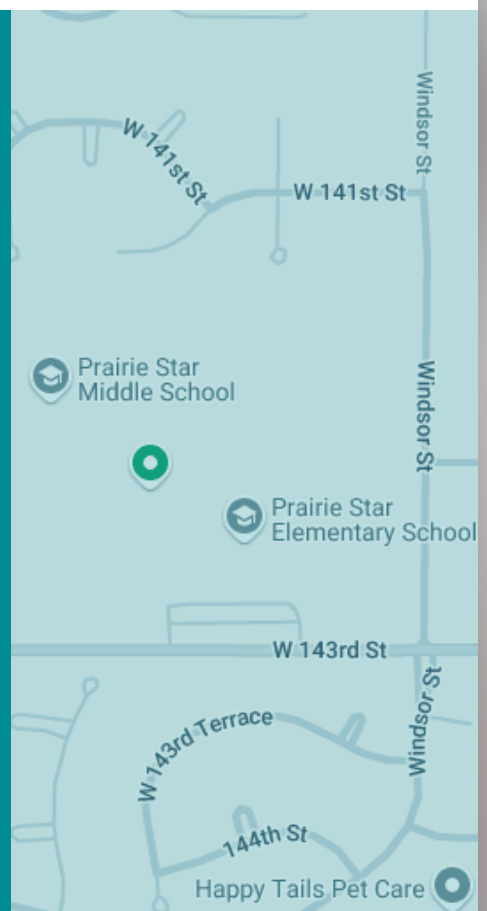

5th-grade parents can enter the gym doors at 8:45. We would like to start our day with students in their classes before the parents enter. Thanks!

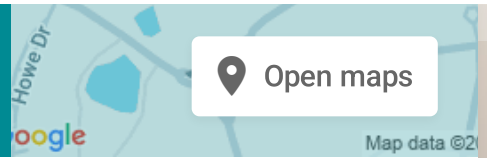

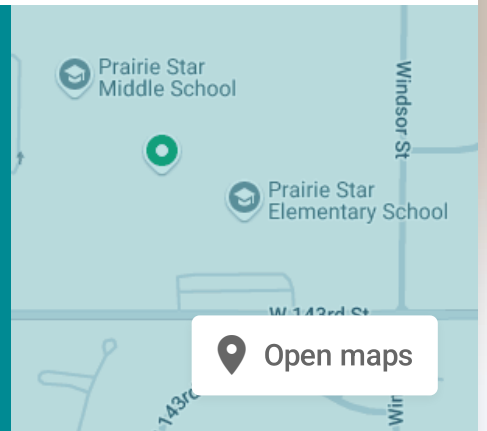

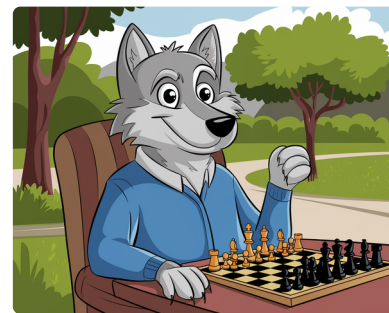

### Calendar Adjustment

This winter has brought an unprecedented number of inclement weather days – eight so far – exceeding the five built into our 2024-25 school calendar. While keeping our students and staff safe remains our top priority, we must also ensure we meet the state’s required instructional time. To put our district in the best position to meet these requirements and maintain our long-standing goal of ending the school year by Memorial Day, we are making the following adjustments:

- **Early March high school late start changes** – There will be no late start on March 4, 6, 11 or 13. School will begin at the normal time on those dates.
  - **Friday, April 25** – The scheduled professional learning day will now be a school day for all students.
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### Mark your calendars for the 2024-25 K-5 teacher professional collaboration days.

As we kick off the 2024-25 school year, I want to remind families about the teacher professional collaboration days designed for teacher plan and collaboration time. These eight days, which occur throughout the school year, are non-student attendance days for K-5 students.
