Safety at the STAR!!

As we begin the school year, we would like your diligence, patience, and care as we establish plans and procedures to keep all of our students safe.

- Drop-off/Pick-up: I will send an updated traffic map by Monday. Please note that it will take a few days for our carline to run smoothly. We appreciate your patience as we help everyone learn the process and retrain our school community as we begin the school year.
- **School Zone**: Please use extra care when driving in school zones and follow the recommended speed limit.
- Parking: Visitors to our building should park in the side lot or the middle school's parking lot.
- Buzz-in Entry: Visitors should come to the front of the school to acquire access during the school day. At the front entrance, visitors will press the buzzer, show a government-issued photo identification, and state the purpose of their visit each time they visit the school. We ask that guests not hold the door open for another visitor once they have been buzzed in. Instead, allow the door to close for each visitor to go through the procedures. I appreciate your support of our safety procedures.

Arrival at PSE

As you and your family are getting back into a school routine, please remember that doors will open at 8:25.

Arrival → Doors open at 8:25 AM. Students arrive naturally anytime between 8:25 and 8:40 when class starts. Walkers will continue to use the front entrance on our new enhanced sidewalk. Bus riders will use the new bus lane and enter through the main doors. Car riders will now use the car rider entrance and enter the main doors via the front sidewalks. All students exiting vehicles need to do so on the curb/school side – do not open left-side vehicle doors, as there is exiting traffic in that area

Dismissal at PSE

Dismissal time will be staggered by a sequential order, and in terms of which exit doors are used:


- Car riders will be in the gym at 3:35 and remain in their until they are called on the walkie, starting a little before 3:40 PM, when their car has arrived in the car loop. Car riders will leave out the gym doors to the car loop. All students exiting vehicles need to do so on the curb/school side do not open left-side vehicle doors, as there is exiting traffic in that area.
- We will provide you with a car tag to place in your vehicle. You may pick up your new car tag at Sneak Peek.
- If you pick up your children on the PSE property, we will radio your child out when we see you on the school grounds around 3:40 PM.**** New location this year**** You will use the sidewalk that goes to the side gym door, #6. You will continue to write your name on the poster board and wait for us to call your name.
- Y-Club students will be dismissed at 3:40 PM to go to the cafeteria, where Y-Club is held.
- Walkers will be dismissed at 3:45 PM. They will exit the main entrance.
- Bus riders will remain in their classroom until it is announced over the intercom that their bus has arrived in the bus lane. Bus riders will exit POD A with staff who will walk them to the bus.



Attendance Alert Options

Every day PSE opens its doors to students for a day filled with learning. When a student does not arrive at school or unexpectedly misses a portion of the school day, we are concerned and want to make sure you are aware that your child is absent.

Beginning Thursday, Aug. 14, families will be notified of unexpected absences through email, phone, text, and optional push notifications.PSE families can expect automated attendance messages by email, phone, and text at 9:35 a.m. if a child is absent and his/her absence has not already been reported by a parent/guardian. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to call the school to report an absence or reply to the automated email or phone message.

Families who would also like a push notification can download the ParentVUE app and manage their notifications. If a child has an unreported absence when a teacher submits attendance, then a push notification will immediately be sent to the parent/guardian's mobile device.

Interested in push notifications? Simply download the ParentVUE app (<u>iTunes app store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>), enable push notifications in device settings, and select attendance notifications through inapp settings.

Reminder of Personal Electronic Device Expectations for BV Students

Blue Valley Schools is committed to providing a safe, positive and productive learning environment for its students. To support this commitment and to limit distractions for all in the learning

environment, the Board of Education approved the Student Use of Cell Phones and Related Personal Electronic Devices policy in 2024.

As a reminder, the following guidelines were implemented last school year and will be continued in 2025-26:

ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS

Student personal electronic devices (PEDs) are to be silenced and stowed away at all times.

- If a student needs to contact their family during the school day, they can use either the main office or classroom phone, with permission.
- If family members need to reach their child, they should call the main office phone.

LUNCH VISITORS BEGINNING September 3rd!

Lunch Visitors: If you would like to visit the lunchroom during your child's lunch, you are welcome to join us after Labor Day. This is a chance to come during special occasions or when your schedule allows. The students are always so excited to have lunch visitors. Here are some guidelines we ask you to follow:

- You will need your government-issued photo ID to enter the building
- Check in at the office and obtain a visitor's sticker
- If a grandparent, aunt, uncle, etc., want to visit for lunch, they must be listed as an Emergency Contact in our student information system or not be allowed to enter the building. Please call the office to add people before the visit.
- If a visitor brings food, it can only be shared with your student
- We will have a visitor's table in the lunchroom for you and your student to sit and eat
- Check out at the office after your student's lunch
