Weekly Update by Mrs. Furdek!

Kindergarten- 2nd grade focused on using their **Smart Guess** Tool Box (eyes, ears, brain, and heart) to make Smart Guess. Students would look at several scenarios and make predictions on what

was happening. We lastly discussed **Hidden Rules**. I asked students to share the hidden rules when we are in a line (no cutting, single file, etc). We then looked at a picture of a movie theater and discussed hidden rules at a movie theater (no talking, do not stand in front of the projector, pick up trash).

Vocab:

Smart Guess: We use this tool to analyze a situation and then make a guess based on our knowledge of the world.

Hidden Rules: these are the rules that tell us what to do in situations. People don't usually talk about them but are expected to know and follow them. Hidden rules are expected behaviors.
