<u>Cell Phones and Earbuds</u> Cell phones stay in the students' locker during the day or classroom caddy within each of their classes. Earbuds or airpods stay in the locker or use in class only when directed by teacher for learning purposes.



<u>Canvas</u> Canvas is the system used for student access to classes, assignments, individual grades, and teacher messages. Your student must grant you access to their Canvas account for you to see their information. <u>Canvas Login</u>

<u>Chromebooks</u> Every ABMS student is issued a Chromebook for school use. Charge it every night (please leave the charging cord at home) and bring it to school every day. 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<u>Counselors</u> ABMS has three counselors that work with students for all three years they are here. They are divided up based on students' <u>last names</u>:

Mr. Pulcini (A - G names), Mrs. Blunt (H - M names), and Mrs. Tally (N - Z names).



<u>Backpacks</u> Students may bring backpacks to/from school but they must be stored in a student's locker during school hours for safety and space reasons. Exceptions may occur if only approved by administration in advance.

Class Schedule 6th grade students and new 7th/8th grade students will get their class schedule on 6th grade/New Student Orientation on August 12th. All students will be able to view their class schedule on ParentVue on the day before school begins. All students will have the 4 core classes (Math, Science, SS, and ELA). The elective classes are determined based upon what the student put on the enrollment form and what is available based on the master schedule. Please note that all students will have PE for 1 semester (either fall or spring semester). Students are actively engaged and participating in PE, so proper shoes and clothing is needed. If students use a locker, they must provide a combination padlock. Families can purchase a PE shirt prior to school through out PTO.

<u>Lockers</u> Students will practice locker combinations a lot during the first week of school. Your student may want to practice on a combination lock at home over summer if worried. Please limit the about of locker decorations your student brings to school so the lock does not jam. Students are not allowed to decorate the outside of their lockers.

School Supply List Each grade level requests families purchase school supplies prior to the beginning of school in August. A list for each grade level is found on the ABMS website and is shared in our all school newsletter. If this presents a financial hardship, please contact our bookkeeper at ABMS at (913) 624-2308.



<u>Snacks and Water Bottles</u> We encourage our students to bring a water bottle to school that they can take with them from class to class. Please make sure it is a water bottle with a lid and labeled with the name. 6th grade has the last lunch of the day, so students may bring a snack with them that they will be allowed to eat during Flex class (2nd hour) .The snack must be nut free.

<u>Student Planners</u> Each 6th grade student will receive a planner that they can use to organize their assignments. Over time many students may prefer to use Canvas as their online planner, but we do provide each 6th grader this planner to help them learn key organizational habits. Planners are given to students during the first few days of school.

<u>Grading\_ABMS</u> teachers typically use the traditional grading system: A (100-90%), B (89-80%), C (79-70%), D (69-60%), F (59 or below). The overall grade consists of daily homework, formative and summative assessments, projects and other classroom learning activities. Each grade level will share with students their expectations about late work, policy of re-take on tests and more.

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<u>Clubs and Activities</u> There are so many clubs and activities at ABMS! Clubs vary by year and are dependent on student interest and sponsors. Students may form a new club if they find a staff sponsor and get club approved by admins. <u>ABMS Clubs</u>



<u>Fees</u> All school fees (registration and individual course fees) are paid via ParentVue. There are also optional fees for yearbooks, PTO membership, etc. <u>If you do not order a yearbook by the January deadline, your student will not receive one!</u>

<u>Grades and Report Cards</u> Grades for individual assignments and tests can be found on Canvas. You can look at each class for a list of upcoming homework, quizzes, and tests that will or have received a grade. Report cards are posted to ParentVue at the end of each quarter.

<u>Item Drop Off</u> If your student forgets an item, you may drop it off in our front office on the table. Please make sure you use a sticky note to label the item with your student's first and last name. Unless it is a time-sensitive, we will wait to call your student to get the item at the end of class.

<u>Lunch Accounts</u> Blue Valley uses a system called LINQ to manage money in your student's lunch account. Your student's account will follow them from one school to another. You will need to create an account and access it via the web or download the app on your phone.



<u>ABMS Weekly Newsletter</u> If there is one thing we want all families to do it is to read the Friday newsletters called ABMS Weekly Newsletter. It is full of information that is important to all our families. Please take a minute each week to stay current on what's happening around ABMS!



ParentVue Your ParentVue account is where your contact information is located. It is also where you will pay fees and where report cards are posted each quarter. If you have more than one child in Blue Valley you can access all your children from your account. ParentVue login
