- Determination (personal initiative)

### WHAT IS AVID?

- •A 4-year elective, academic class for a cohort of students
- A prescribed program taught by AVID-trained teachers
- High academic expectations combined with specific strategies and practices to support students in taking a challenging course load
- Exposure to habits designed to support student college readiness

- Is willing to commit to AVID for four years

- A remedial class or a study hall
- An easy "A"
- A fix for current academic difficulty
- For students who continually miss deadlines or have a lot of zeros
- For students who lack the desire to pursue honors and AP courses
- For students already enrolled in a full course load of honors classes
