



Electronic Technician

Through a partnership with Garmin and Johnson County Community College, students may begin work on an Electronic Technician Associate Degree while still in high school. This highly engaging, hands-on and work based curriculum will prepare students for immediate employment at Garmin while students also earn college credit towards their associate degree.

Courses will be held in the Garmin lab at the CAPS building for three hours a day during both the junior and senior years. During the program, Garmin will interview students and offer placements for internships as well as job offers for graduates. Garmin's Electronic Technicians can be eligible for tuition reimbursement which means that students could ultimately complete their entire associate degree at no cost while working at Garmin after graduation.
