Upcoming closure at 167th Street, U.S. 69 Interchange

As part of the U.S. 69 Expansion Project (69Express)—a major initiative to improve traffic flow and safety—construction work will soon impact travel near 167th Street.

From March 6-9, one lane in both directions on U.S. 69 will be closed from 159th Street to just before 179th Street for bridge demolition at the 167th Street interchange.

From April-October, 167th Street at U.S. 69, including ramps, will be closed. U.S. 69 over 167th Street will be reduced to one lane each way. Additional information can be found on 69Express' Road Closure Update webpage.

While not a school district project, this may affect travel for families. Any impacts to school transportation will be communicated by Durham School Services and All Point Transportation. Please plan ahead and consider alternate routes as needed.

Testing Day is April 8th

Tuesday, April 8th, is our school-wide testing day for 9th-11th grade students.

Bus Transportation: Durham will run morning routes at standard pick-up times and will pick students up at noon once testing concludes. If your student receives testing accommodations extending their test, you will need to make alternate transportation arrangements for them to be
