Save the Date - Fall 2024 PSAT NMSQT

Next school year, the PSAT will be administered on **Friday**, **October 11th**, **2024**. This is a nonschool day for all students who have not signed up for the PSAT.

Who typically takes the PSAT?

- PSAT NMSQT (Preliminary SAT, National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) 10th graders who want to practice for the high-stakes PSAT NMSQT in preparation for the high-stakes opportunity in 11th grade.
- PSAT NMSQT (Preliminary SAT, National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) for juniors, the PSAT NMSQT is high-stakes, as students who score exceptionally well (typically the top 3% nationally) can qualify for the National Merit Scholarship competition.

**Bus transportation will pick up and drop off any student who is already accessing district transportation.

BV Well Mental Health Graduation Checklist

The <u>BV Well Mental Health Guide</u> is a document for Senior students and families to be proactive in supporting their young adult through the transition from high school to their post-secondary pursuits. This document was created in recognition that this age of student population can be at risk for mental health support. According to the Jason Foundation, college aged youth, ages 18-22, suicide is the 3rd leading cause of death and overall, suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death for youth ages 10-24. The intention is to help families be proactive to support their student as they make these post-secondary transitions. Check out the <u>BV Well website</u> for more information.


