Freshman Orientation

This is a required event for all 9th graders.

Date: Tuesday, August 12, 2025. Students will be reporting to their Advisory classrooms.

Time: 7:35 am - 10:30 am, students should plan to arrive early, programming begins promptly at 7:35.

Message from the School Nurse

Medications: Students are allowed to carry OTC (over the counter) medications on them at school as long as they are in the original bottle. PSAT/NMSQT Registration - Sophomores & Juniors

Registration for the PSAT/NMSQT (Preliminary SAT, National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test) is now open. The PSAT will be administered on Friday, October 10. This is a non-school day for all students who have not signed up for the PSAT. Please click here-psat/ for more information.

***If your student receives a testing accommodation through an IEP/504, you must register & pay by 8/15/25 to request accommodations through the College Board.

Who typically takes the PSAT?

PSAT NMSQT (Preliminary SAT, National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)—This is a digital test for 10th graders who want to practice for the high-stakes PSAT NMSQT in preparation for the high-stakes opportunity in 11th grade.

PSAT NMSQT - for juniors is high-stakes, as students who score exceptionally well (typically in the top 3%) can qualify for the National Merit Scholarship competition. The PSAT NMSQT is digital.

Traffic & Safety

As we begin the school year, we would like to ask for your diligence, patience, and care as we establish plans and procedures to keep all of our students safe.

- **Drop-off/Pick-Up:** Please <u>click here</u> to review our school drop off and parking maps and read <u>this email message</u> for expectations for all families. Remember, it will take a few days for our carline to run smoothly. Therefore, we appreciate your patience as we help everyone learn the process and retrain our school community as we start the school year.
- Buzz-in Entry: Visitors should come to the front of the school to acquire access during the school day. At the front entrance, visitors will press the buzzer, show a government issued photo identification and state the purpose for their visit each time they visit the school. We ask that guests do not hold the door open for another visitor once you have been buzzed in. Instead, allow the door to close for each visitor to go through the procedures. Thank you for your support of our safety procedures.

Personal Electronic Device Expectations

Blue Valley Schools is committed to providing a safe, positive and productive learning environment for its students. To support this commitment and to limit distractions for all in the learning environment, the Board of Education approved the Student Use of Cell Phones and Related Personal Electronic Devices policy in 2024.

As a reminder, the following guidelines were implemented last school year and will be continued in 2025-26:

Start and End of Class:

- When the bell rings to start class, personal electronic devices (PEDs) must be silenced and stowed away. We have found this prepares students for learning.
- When the bell rings to end class, PEDs can be used until the next class and during lunch.

During Class/Advisory Time:

• Unless otherwise instructed by a teacher for instructional purposes, students should keep PEDs silenced and stowed away.

Restroom:

• Students are required to leave PEDs in the classroom when using the restroom as we have found this reduces their time out of class.

Securely

Securly Home: Partnering for Your Child's Online Safety

Securly is the leading solution in keeping children safe online at school. Now parents can get the same peace of mind when school devices come home. See your child's online activity in real-time and catch up with our weekly email snapshots.

Eligibility: Only for parents listed as "Lives With & Edu Rights" in Synergy.

Take an active role in your child's digital safety with Securly Home, the district's cloud-based filtering system.

Key Features

- Monitor & Customize Filters: Use the Securly Home Parent Portal app (<u>Apple App Store</u> or <u>Google Play</u>) to monitor and adjust filters on district devices used outside the BV Network. Available for families with district-issued Chromebooks/MacBooks.
- Self-Harm Alerts: Receive mobile push notifications if your child searches self-harm content on district devices.

- Pause Internet Access: Temporarily disable internet access on your child's district device outside the school network.
- Weekly Activity Reports: Get weekly email summaries of your child's online activity (reports show all online activity after they leave the school network. Unsubscribe anytime.

Setup Tips

- Accounts are linked to the email in "email line #1" in ParentVUE.
- Need help updating your email in ParentVUE? Contact your school's front office.
- For setup support, submit a BV Care ticket via the BVSD website.

Note: Parent Custom Filters apply only when devices are not connected to the BV Network. Once reconnected, district filters resume.

Registration for 25-26 School Year

If you haven't registered your student for the 2025-26 school year, please do so now! <u>High school</u> registration

Registration is required annually and is the time to update your student's information and pay fees. Simply log in and click the registration tab to begin.

If you are moving and your student will not attend BVW this school year, please contact our registrar asap at mlburch@bluevalleyk12.org to initiate a records request.

To register your child, you must:

- Know ParentVUE login: You will need your <u>ParentVUE</u> login/password to complete registration. Need help figuring out your login/password? Call our registrar at 913-239-3708.
- Review/Update Information: Registration is the time to review/update information about your child, including phone, email, emergency contacts, health data, etc.
- Pay Fees: Families have access to pay all fees except second-semester course fees.

Please note: This year, schedules are viewable on the evening of August 8th. Students and families will not be able to see the schedule until online registration is completed.

Understanding Payments in Blue Valley

Blue Valley Schools uses several secure systems to manage school-related payments. Each system the district uses is designed for a specific purpose and specific items or fees. This <u>quick</u> guide can be found on the BV Website to provide guidance for making payments.

Attendance Reporting & Notifications

Attendance notifications will begin on the second day of school for all levels—Thursday, August 14. Families can expect automated attendance messages by email, phone and text at 10:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. if a child is absent and his/her absence has not already been reported by a parent/guardian. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to call the school to report an absence, report the absence online or reply to the automated email or phone message.
