<u>High School Registration</u> for the 2025-26 school year is now open for current students. At this time, you can pay all required fees — except course fees, which will be assigned in September — as well as some optional fees. Registration is required annually and is the time to update your child's information (phone, email, emergency contacts, health information, etc).

Beginning in 2025-26, all 6th and 9th graders will be required to provide proof of residency (a current purchase contract, lease or utility bill, within the attendance area for your address) as part of the transition to a new level.

Completing registration confirms your child's attendance in August and helps the district appropriately staff classrooms. Thank you for providing this important information as part of the registration process. For more registration information, visit www.bluevalleyk12.org/registration.

Physicals and Registration for the 2025-26 School Year

Typically, on May 1, we begin collecting physicals and required paperwork for the upcoming school year. However, the Blue Valley District is transitioning to a new system for managing this process, which will not be available until **June 1, 2025**.

- **High School Cheer and Dance Teams:** If you need a physical for summer participation, you may still upload your documents through the current system.
- All Other Students: Please wait until the new system is live on June 1 to submit your paperwork.

We will provide detailed instructions once the new system is ready. Please note: to be eligible for any KSHSAA activity during the 2025–26 school year, physicals must be dated **after May 1, 2025**.
